

Material List:


Hook: Size 14-8

Bead: Match to hook size

Tail: Grizzly Marabou, Red Holographic Tinsel

Wire: Small Silver


Hackle: Grizzly **Body:** Iced Dubbing



Top lead is round, bottom lead has been flattened. (Size .025)



Flattened lead used to reduce bulk of the fly



Secure lead with wraps at the bend of the hook.



Tie in tail.



Add red flash on each side of tail.



Tie in silver wire.



Tie in hackle.



Dubbed body, tapered forward to bead.



Palmer hackle forward to bead, secure with thread.



Wrap wire forward to bead, secure with thread.



Whip finish
