Men's and Women's Skills, Accuracy & Distance

BASICS:

Fly Casting will be held in the Neil Road Recreation Center Gym. Competitors will be divided by groups of men and women, and by age, based on the number of entries.

There are three independent fly casting events for the 2018 Summer Games.


All of the events will be conducted with 3wt fly rods.

- 1. Accuracy Participants will cast toward round targets (hula hoops) placed on the ground with points awarded for casts landing in the targets.
- 2. Distance Participants will cast for distance five times. The three longest casts will be combined for their total score.
- 3. Speed Participants will cast to a variety of set targets, varying sizes and shapes, with points awarded for accuracy.

Fly rods will be provided. Each event will be contested with the same 3wt rod.

All participants are welcome to practice with their own fly rods before the competition begins, but will not be allowed to utilize their own equipment during any of the three contests.
